GMHA Show Info, Rules & Policies

Entry

- Fees made payable to GMHA. Checks, cash, and Visa/MC are accepted. There will be a 3% Non-Cash adjustment charged to all credit card transactions.
- •GMHA liability waiver MUST be signed to receive entry packet. Riders must sign for themselves and parents must sign for a junior rider (trainer is not permitted to sign as agent). Trainer may sign as agent for owner.
- •Online entries are accepted and encouraged: check out www.horseshowing.com.
- Negative Coggins test and proof of rabies vaccination with-in 12 months is required.
- •Show management reserves the right to cancel, combine, or split classes as entries warrant, change the show schedule, and substitute officials.
- •Scratches: There is no penalty to scratch a class, or add a class during the show, as long as it is done by filling out a scratch/add form in the show secretary's office PRIOR to the start of the class. No refunds will be given if a ride is scratched after the class has begun.
- •\$50 entry scratch fee per entry. No charge to swap horse/rider.
- •If two riders per entry, entry to be paid with ONE form of payment.

Awards

- •Ribbons through 8th place in each class.
- Division Champions & Reserve Champions receive and trophy- 3 entries required for Champion/Reserve to be awarded.
- •Champion and reserve in each division based on points given to the first 6 places (10-6-4-2-1-.5). Hunter division awards will be given to 2 of the 4 horses which have acquired the most points over fences; only those horses will be awarded points for ribbons won under saddle. Ties will be broken by points won over fences.
- •Ties for other than first place in a jumper class will be broke by a coin toss.

Stabling

- 165 10'x10' permanent box stalls, all with solid doors and rubber mats. Additional temporary 10'x10' stalls. Tack stalls available. No bedding is provided; may pre-purchase shavings/hay or bring with you.
- Stalls are to be stripped upon departure. Will be billed \$50 for a dirty stall.

- GMHA has European Geo-Textile footing in all rings.
- Competition Rings are approximately 120'x280' (White Ring) and 150'x268' (Walker Ring), 240'x180' (Upwey Ring).

- Woodstock Town Zoning PROHIBITS CAMPING OF ANY KIND on GMHA Grounds.
- Food available on grounds.
- EMT on-grounds during show. Veterinarian on-grounds and farrier on-grounds/on-call depending on show. Phone numbers will be posted in the show office. Emergency number is 911.
- Strict Dog Policy Pets must be leashed at all times. \$30 fee for each off-leash occurrence.
- Horses may only be ridden by riders, trainers, coaches, and owners who have signed the entry blank.

Refunds

• Refund will be given less \$50 Entry Scratch Fee for the complete scratch of an entry. No charge for adding/scratching classes, horse/rider switches. Stabling fees will not be refunded UNLESS your stall can be filled from a waiting list.

150. 2' Hunter Derby

One round, fences not to exceed 2'. Open to all riders on horses and ponies. Not to show over 2'6'' at this show.

151. 2'6" Hunter Derby

Open to all horse and ponies. Not to show over 3'. Two rounds- top 10 will compete in 2nd round- handy course.

152. 3' Hunter Derby

Open to all horse and ponies. Two rounds- top 10 will compete in 2nd round-handy course.

Experience the thrill of Derby Day, a special highlight of the GMHA August Hunter Jumper Show! Unlike our other derbies, this one-of-a-kind event takes place on grass footing, simulating the feel of an authentic outside hunt course.

991: \$500 2'6" Jr/ Adult Hunter Derby - NEHC "AA" Rated

Open to Junior and Adult Amateur riders. Horse and rider combination not to compete in classes which exceed 3' at this show.

993: \$500 3' Hunter Derby

Open to all riders on horses or ponies. Horse and rider combination may not compete in any class at this show which exceeds 3'3".

Awards: Prize money awarded as follows: \$500: 1st place- \$300, 2nd place- \$125, 3rd place- \$75. Ribbons to 10th place.

First round: Classic course consisting of at least 8 traditional hunt-type obstacles not to exceed class height. Fences to simulate those found an outside hunt course- may include post and rail, walls, logs, coops, water crossings, brush, and hedge.

Second round: The top 10 entries from the first round to compete over a handy course not to exceed class height. Option fences may be set 3 inches higher than class height. To be judged on style, brilliance, and handiness. 3' derby may include a water crossing.

Equitation Derbies: To be shown over at least 8 traditional hunt type obstacles not to exceed class height. Fences to simulate those found on an outside hunt course. Course to include two or more of the following: trot fence, halt, back, roll back, or hand gallop (at course designer's discretion. To be judged on style, hands, seat, and control of mount. Top 5 riders may be called back to test. Ribbons through 10th place. Horse and rider combinations may enter one Equitation Derby class only!

992: \$300 3' Junior/Adult Amateur Equitation Derby: Open to all junior and riders who are not competing in classes which exceed 3'3".

990: 2'6" Junior/Adult Amateur Equitation Derby: Open to all junior and adult amateur riders who are not competing in classes which exceed 2'9" at this show.
