Unjudged Warm-ups will run all day starting with ground-poles as a PAID entry. Warm-ups may be entered once at each height by each horse/rider combination. (Exceptions at Show Manager's discretion). Warm up must be first round. Warm-up course will be AS POSTED.

CHAMP/RES. WILL BE AWARDED IN ALL DIVISIONS WITH 4 OR MORE HORSES ENTERED.

Jumper Rules: All first & third round Jumper Classes of each Division to be run as Table II, Sec. 2b (with jump-off to immediately follow first round). All second round Jumper Classes to be run as SPEED (Table II, Sec. 1- no jump off). All 4th round Jumper Classes to be run as Table II, Sec.2a with riders to return for j/o in reverse order of time of first round (slowest to fastest). Ties other than 1st place in jumper classes to be broken by a coin flip.

4 Jumper Classes will contribute points to the Division Championship; champion and reserve only awarded if the division is 4 or more horses entered.

*** As in previous years: THF Team Jumper Chase!**

Sign up a team of barn mates or just friends! \$10 per horse/ rider combination to register; 3 members needed minimum, 5 maximum per team. Each team member rides in A DIFFERENT ONE of the *Jumper Speed classes. 3 fastest times per team are recorded.

Fastest team overall wins; prizes for each of 3 winning riders and the trophy!

SPECIFICATIONS for non-VHJA Classes:

Equitation Derbies: to be shown over at least 8 obstacles and will include some solid fences to simulate outside hunt course obstacles. Course to include 2 or more of the following: trot fence, halt, back, roll back, or hand gallop at course designer's discretion. Up to 5 top riders may be called back to test at judge's discretion, on the flat or over fences.
