- Management has the right to combine classes as needed
- Management has the right to change the call back order or number dependent on show schedule
- Champion and Reserve Champion Ribbons will be awarded to divisions of two or more riders. Prizes will be awarded to divisions of three or more.
- Jumper Classes: all first round jumper classes will be run as Table II section 2B, with jump off to immediately follow first round. All second round classes will be run as Table II section 1, speed round to be won by fastest and clearest.
- Stalls must be cleaned before leaving the show grounds. Stall cleaning is available for \$40.00.
- Participants are encouraged to bring their own shavings. Limited shavings available, if needed, at a cost of \$12.00 per bag.

### JUMPER SATURDAY AFTERNOON CLASSES (SPECIFIC INFORMATION):

- WARM UP ROUNDS ARE BLUE/RED ROUNDS. THAT IS, THOSE WHO GO CLEAR IN THE TIME ALLOWED WILL RECEIVE A BLUE RIBBON. THOSE WITH JUMP PENALTIES BUT WHO COMPLETE IN THE TIME ALLOWED WILL RECEIVE A RED RIBBON.
- ALL FIRST ROUND JUMPER CLASSES WILL BE RUN AS TABLE II SECTION 2B, WITH JUMP OFF TO IMMEDIATELY FOLLOW FIRST ROUND. ALL SECOND ROUND CLASSES WILL BE RUN AS TABLE II SECTION 1, SPEED ROUND TO BE WON BY FASTEST AND CLEAREST.
- INDOOR ARENA WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR SCHOOLING ALL DAY AT NO EXTRA COST
