<p><b>Competition Rings:</b>          Show ring is a 100 x 200 foot, wood fenced, sand ring.           Schooling ring is an outdoor sand ring approximately 75 x 150 feet.           Indoor ring is also available for lunging and schooling.</p>	<p><b>Stalls:</b>          Stalls are limited and are available on a first come, first serve basis. Stalls must be cleaned before leaving the show grounds. Stalls are bedded, and participants are encouraged to bring their own additional shavings if desired, however shavings will be available if needed for an additional fee.</p>
<p><b>Adds/Scratches:</b>          There is no penalty for scratching or adding a class during the show as long as it is done PRIOR to the start of the class or division. No refunds will be provided if the class or division has begun.           No new entries will be accepted on the same show day.</p>	<p><b>Entry Requirements:</b>          Liability waiver MUST be signed by the competitor or parent/guardian. Trainers may not sign as agent for Juniors, though they may sign as agent for Owner.           Negative Coggins test and proof of rabies within 12 months is required.</p>
<p>- Ribbons will be awarded for placings 1-6. Champion and Reserve Champion ribbons and prizes will be awarded to divisions of three or more riders. Champion and Reserve Champion ribbons will be awarded in divisions of two riders.          - Management may limit warm-ups to one round per horse/rider combination.          -Management has the right to combine classes as needed.
